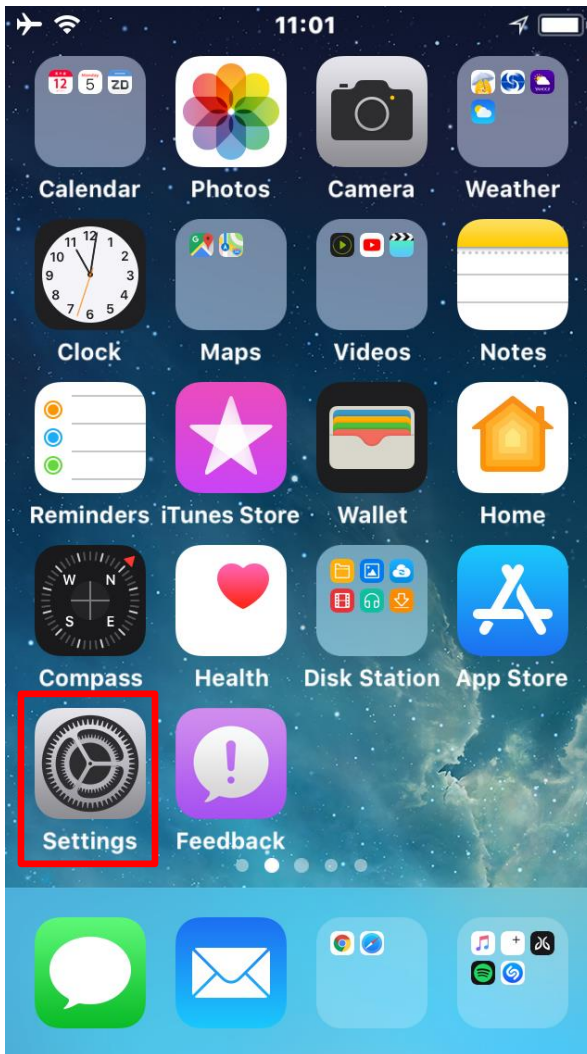


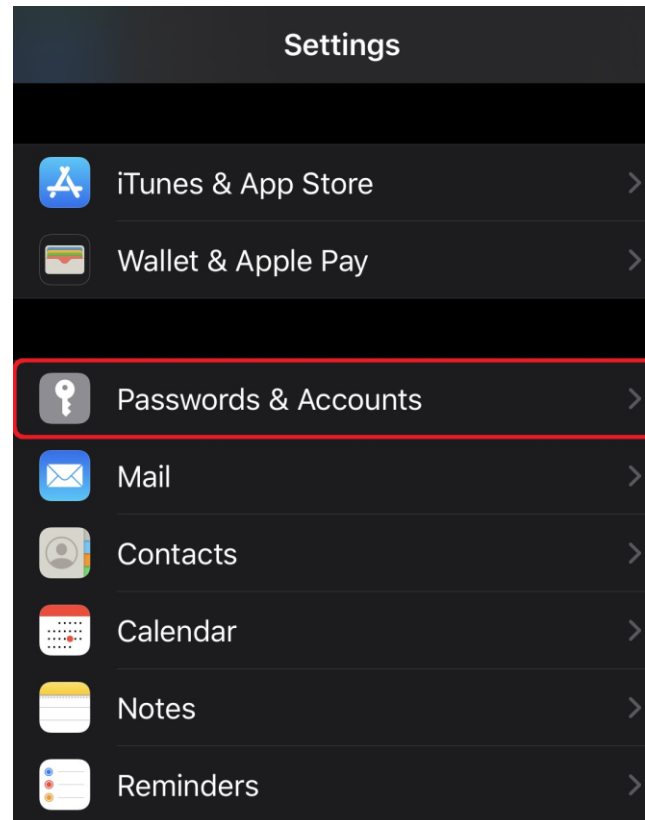
Setting up your e-mail account on iOS

** The setup for iPad is similar.

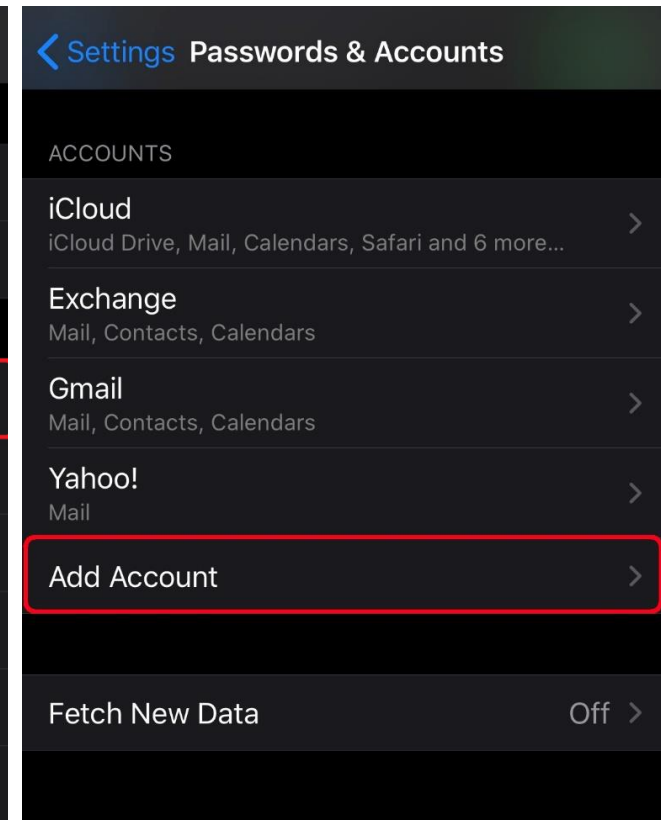
Step 1: Go to **Settings**



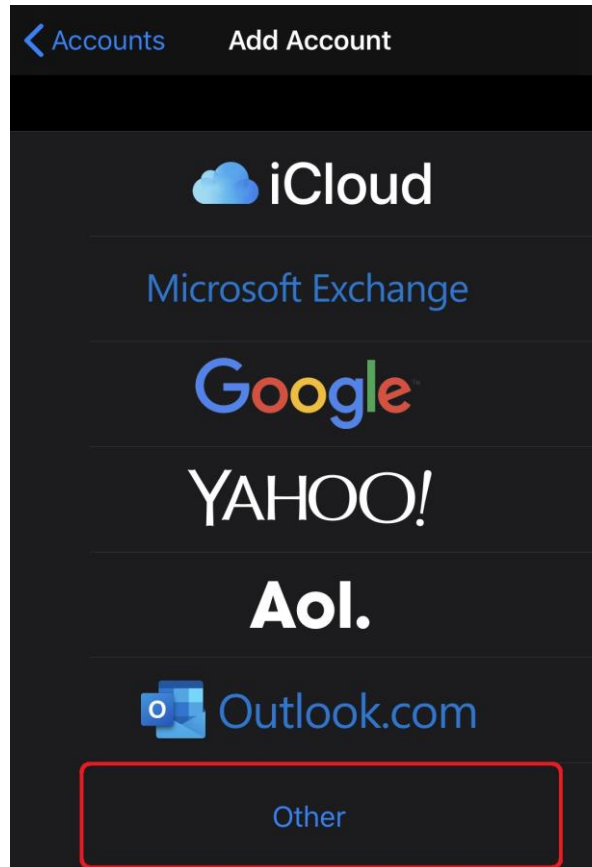
Step 2: Scroll down a bit, tap **Passwords & Accounts**



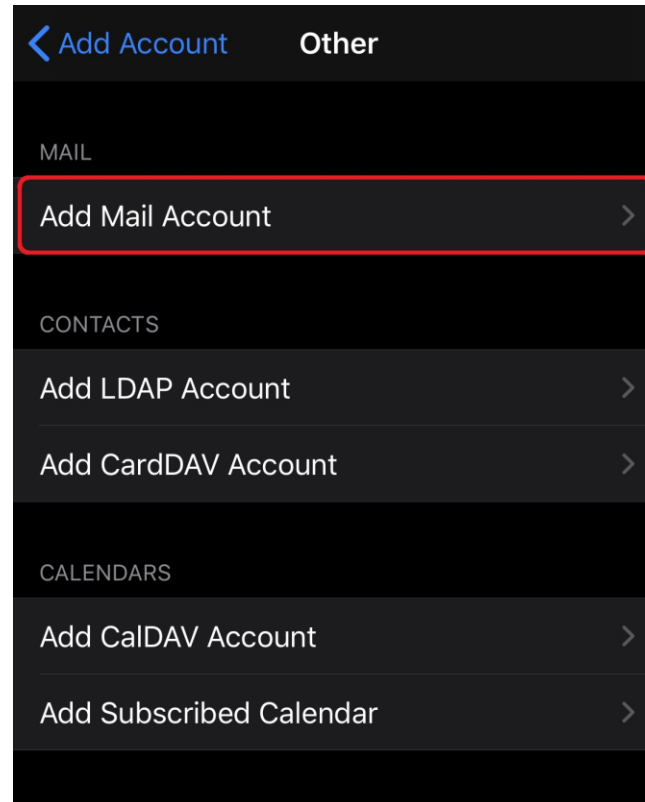
Step 3: Tap **Add Account**



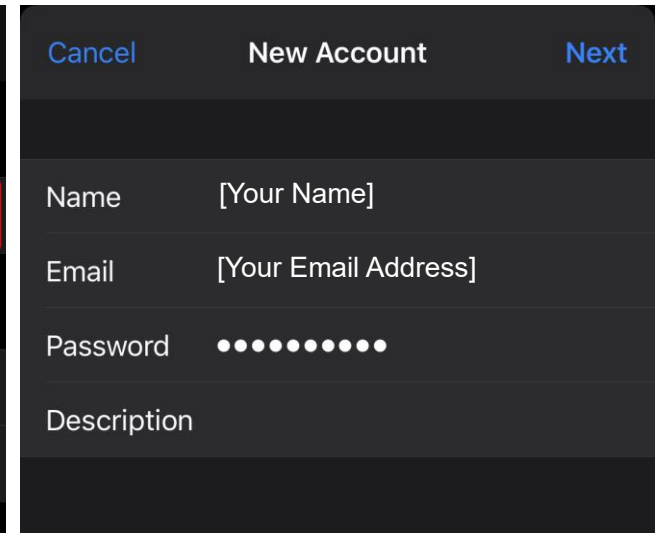
Step 4: Tap **Other**

Tap **Add Mail Account**



Step 6:
Enter your account details,
Then Tap **Next**

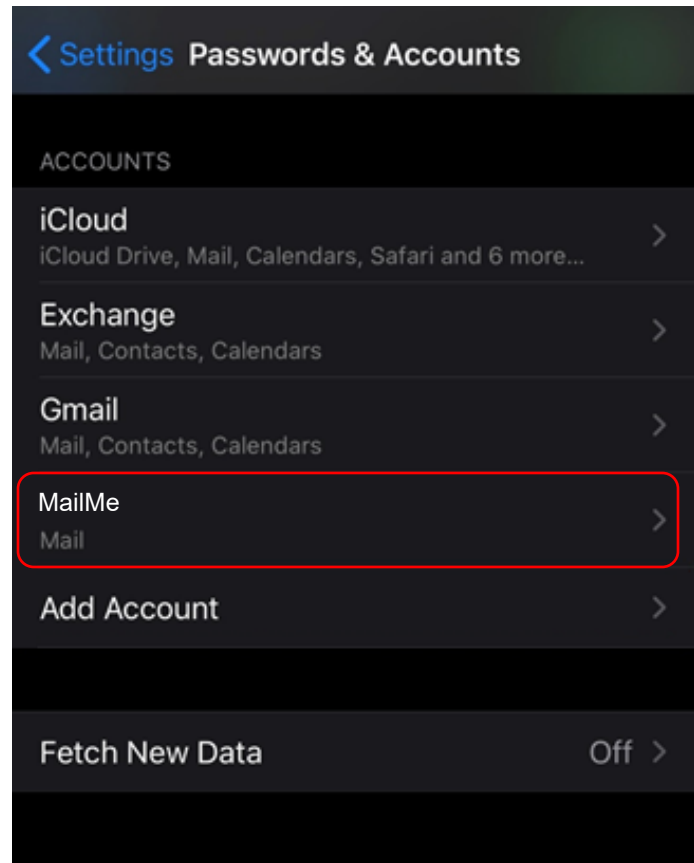

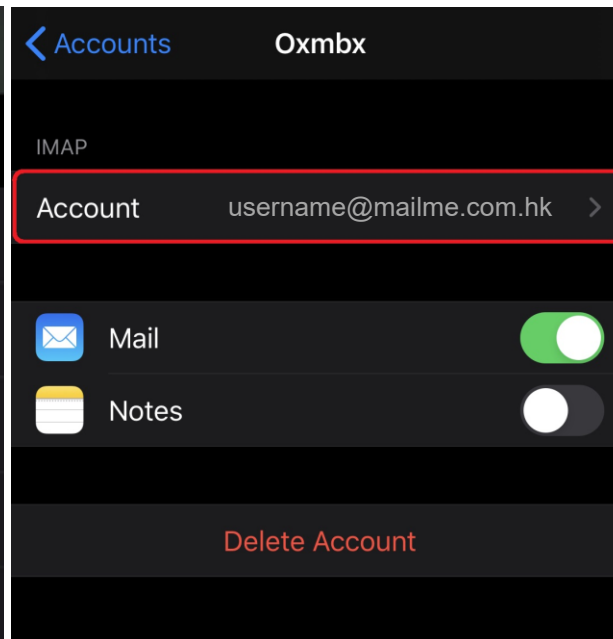

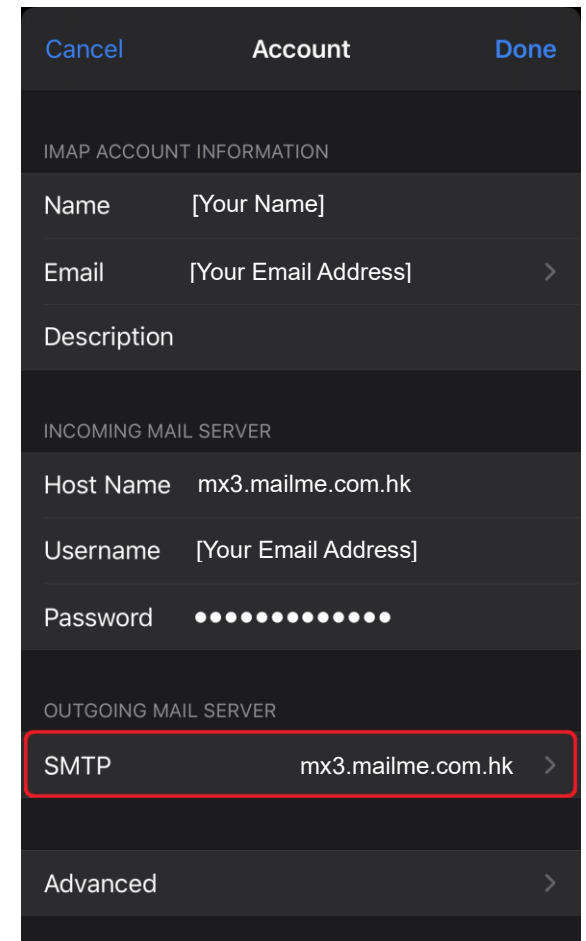

Tap **Account** to proceed to the next step



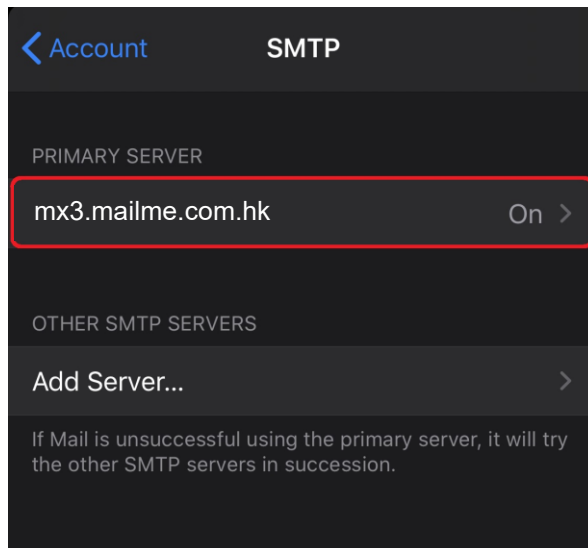
Step 12:

In the **Account**, Tap **SMTP**



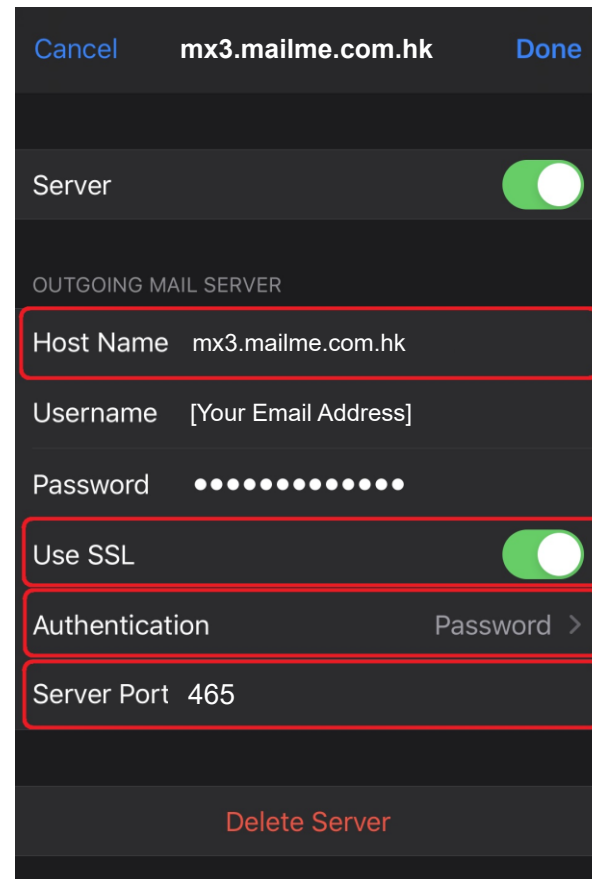
Step 13:

Tap **mx3.mailme.com.hk**, which should be your Primary Server



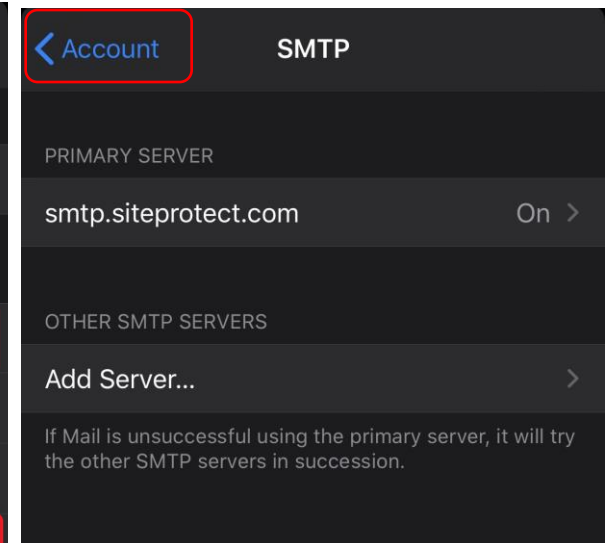
Step 14:

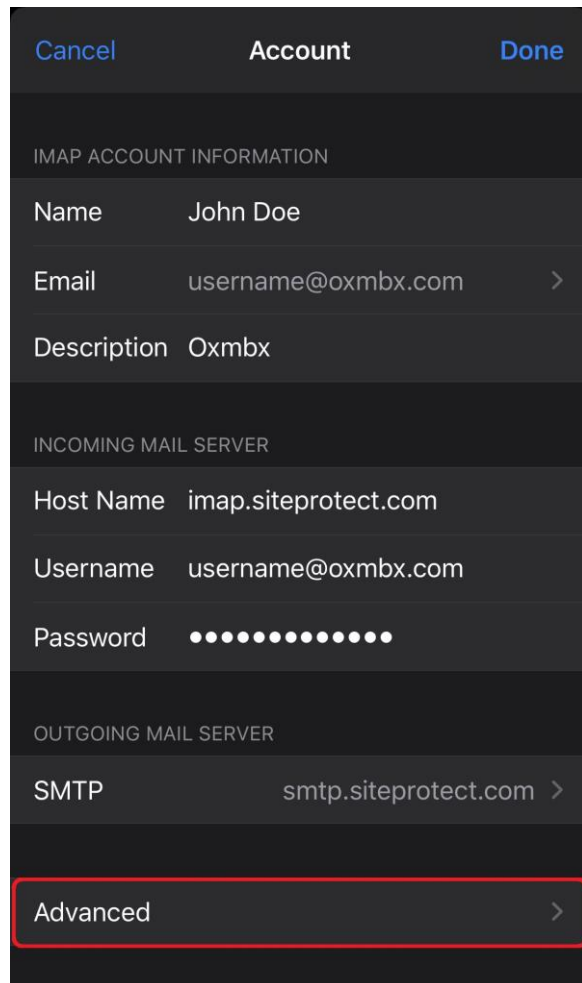

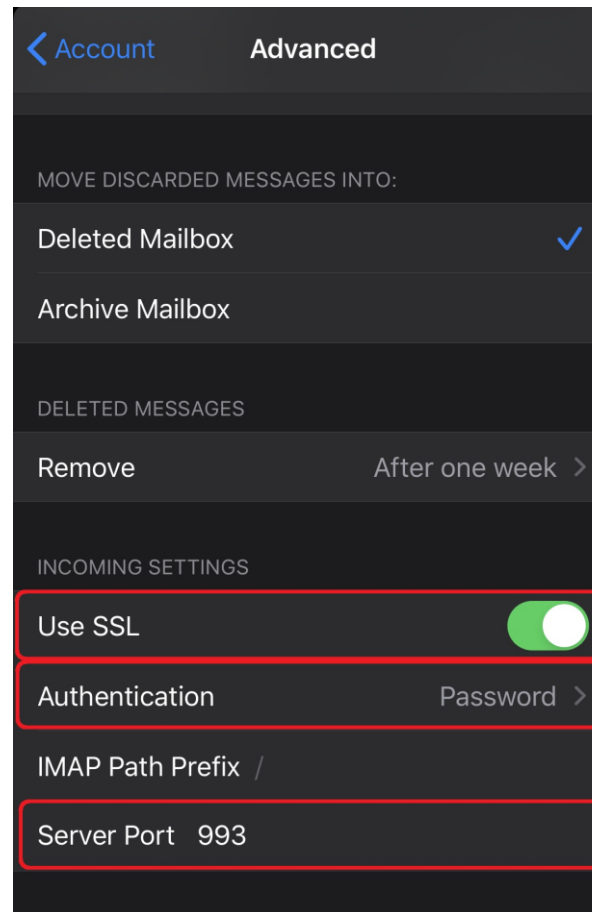
Tap **Done**, after verification, you will be taken back to **SMTP**, Tap < **Account**

In **Account**, Tap **Advanced**



Step 17:
Scroll down to the bottom
Make sure **SSL** has **enabled**.
Authentication: Password
Server Port: 993
